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About the workshop

This two-day workshop offers a practice-oriented learning environment. Through a series of structured roleplays, participants will explore key elements of the therapeutic process, including preparation, the journey session (without the use of substances), and integration.

Each roleplay involves three perspectives: the therapist, the client/patient, and the witness. This allows participants to engage with and reflect on different dimensions of the therapeutic experience.

Particular emphasis is placed on challenging, complex, and potentially disruptive sessions, supporting participants in developing skills and confidence in navigating difficult therapeutic moments.

The workshop concludes with a large-group integration session, a space for shared reflection, dialogue, and questions.

Participants are invited to explore their experiences from multiple perspectives, with special attention to working with challenging processes and deepening their understanding of relational and therapeutic dynamics.

Jeffrey Guss, MD is a psychiatrist, psychoanalyst, and researcher with specializations in psychoanalytic therapy, psychedelic therapy and the integration of psychedelic therapy with analytic principles and methods. He is on the Faculty of the NYU Postdoctoral Program in Psychotherapy and Psychoanalysis, and a Clinical Assistant Professor of Psychiatry at NYU Grossman Medical Center. Dr. Guss is a Lead Trainer with Fluence, an educational setting for psychedelic therapy training.

Dr Guss' primary area of interest is the integration of psychedelic therapies with contemporary psychoanalytic theory and practice, and in particular transference and countertransference in psychedelic therapy. His paper, "A Psychoanalytic Perspective on Psychedelic Experience", was published in *Psychoanalytic Dialogues* in 2022 and also has published in *Studies in Gender and Sexuality and Psychoanalysis, Culture and Society*. He co-authored a paper on the influence of therapists' firsthand experience with psychedelics on psychedelic-assisted psychotherapy research in *The Journal of Psychedelic Studies* and conducts clinical consultation group with practicing psychedelic integration therapists. .

Dr. Guss served as Co-Principal Investigator and Director of Psychedelic Therapy Training for the NYU School of Medicine's study on psilocybin-assisted psychotherapy in the treatment of cancer related existential distress, which was published in *Journal of Psychopharmacology*, 2016. He was a study therapist in the NYU study on Psilocybin-Assisted treatment of Major Depressive Disorder, a collaborator with Yale University's study on psilocybin-assisted therapy for Major Depressive Disorder and a study therapist with the MAPS study on treatment of Post Traumatic Stress Disorder with MDMA-Assisted Psychotherapy and the NYU research study on Psilocybin Assisted Therapy for Alcohol Use Disorder.

He is on the board of the International Society for Substance-Assisted Psychotherapy and maintains a private practice in New York City.
